

Additional information for piano students attending the Suzuki Festival in April

All piano students in books 1 to 5 inclusive will participate in Play-In classes. A play-In is a large group class where everyone plays the same nominated pieces together. In addition the Standard Program Students will also have Ensemble Classes.

Book 1-5 level students should revise the pieces listed for their level – as many as they have learned – so they can participate in the play-in session.

When there is a piece a student can't play, observation and listening to the other students is a great way of starting to learn these later pieces.

Book 6 and above will have their own program.

Junior Program - Students in Book 1 - Tutorials, Play-Ins, Enrichment

Tutorial pieces: 3 pieces for each class (from Book 1). Appropriate pieces will be determined once enrolments have been completed. Families will be informed.

For example, if students are in book 2 and have learned up to Cradle Song then students should revise the Twinkles, Go Tell Aunt Rhody, Little Playmates, Allegro (all from book 1) plus Ecosaise, Happy Farmer and Minuet in G Major (graduation piece) from book 2.

Ensemble Piece: The Comedians Galop (D. Kabalesky). Music will be supplied.

Tutorial Pieces: 2 pieces from Book 2. Appropriate pieces will be determined once enrolments have been completed. Families will be informed.

Students in Book 3, 4 and 5 - Tutorials, Play-Ins, Ensembles, Enrichment

For example, if you are a book 3 student who has learned up to Wild Rider you should revise Twinkles and Allegro from Book 1, Ecosaise, Arietta and Sonatina in G, 1st mvt, from book 2 and Sonatina Op 36 No 1, 3rd mvt and Theme from Book 3.

Ensemble Piece: Trepak 'Russian Dance' from The Nutcracker (Tchaikovsky).
Music will be supplied.

Tutorial Pieces: 2 pieces from Books 3 ~ 5. Appropriate pieces will be determined once enrolments have been completed. Families will be informed.

Enrichment

Senior Students – from Book 6 upwards

Master classes (choice of own pieces)

Ensemble Piece: La Campanella, 6 hands. Music will be provided.
