

BEHAVIOUR CODE FOR STUDENTS

POLICY

Suzuki Talent Education Association of Australia (NSW) Limited (Suzuki) is committed to providing safe, positive, supportive and responsive learning environments for everyone. We teach and model the behaviours we value in our students. We follow the Suzuki philosophy in all our actions.

PROCEDURE

Suzuki students are expected to:

- Respect other students, teachers, Suzuki staff and Suzuki volunteers.
- Follow the directions of the teachers, staff and volunteers at events
 - Respect all members of the Suzuki community and show courtesy to all students, teachers and community members
 - Resolve conflict respectfully, calmly and fairly
 - Comply with Suzuki dress code at events
 - Attend rehearsals and events at specific set times
 - Respect all property
- Not bully, harass, intimidate or discriminate against anyone at our events. Suzuki will take strong action in response to behaviour that is detrimental to self or others or to the achievement of high-quality teaching and learning at events. If deemed necessary at Suzuki events Parents will be asked to remove their children from the event if their child displays unacceptable behaviour.

Behaviour Code for Students: Actions

Promoting the learning, wellbeing and safety of all students at events is a high priority for Suzuki. We implement teaching and learning approaches to support the development of skills needed by students to meet our high standards for respectful, safe and engaged behaviour.

Respect

- Treat one another with dignity
- Speak and behave courteously
- Cooperate with others

- Develop positive and respectful relationships and think about the effect on relationships before acting
- Value the interests, ability and culture of others
- Dress appropriately by complying with the dress code
- Take care with property

Safety

- Model and follow Suzuki codes of behaviour and conduct
- Negotiate and resolve conflict with empathy
- Take personal responsibility for behaviour and actions
- Care for self and others
- Avoid dangerous behaviour and encourage others to avoid dangerous behaviour

Engagement

- Arrive at rehearsals and events/classes on time
- Be prepared for every lesson
- Actively participate in learning
- Aspire and strive to achieve the highest standards of learning

Suzuki staff and teachers, using their professional judgment, are best placed to maintain discipline and provide safe, supportive and responsive learning environments. Suzuki provides a policy framework and resources to access to specialist advice, and professional learning to guide teachers and their staff in exercising their professional judgment.

Parents will be contacted if a child needs to be removed from an event.
