How to Submit your Virtual Performances

When exporting your video from your device, please ensure it is a **high-resolution file** (minimum 1080 x 1920). If you can attach it to an email, it is too small. It should be at least hundreds of megabytes in size.

Please upload the file using the link below. This allows you to upload directly to the **Suzuki Google drive** folder from your smartphone, tablet, or computer. If you are concerned about using too much of your mobile data allocation, you can copy the high-resolution file from your phone to a computer via a USB cable and then upload from the computer.
