

National Conference 2020 – Piano Repertoire Class (Play-in Together).

All Piano students in books 1-5 inclusive will participate in repertoire classes (Play-ins). A repertoire class is a large group class where everyone plays the repertoire together.

Like string students, the piano students will have a large group experience too as part of the Piano program.

Students should revise the pieces below – as many as they have learned – so that they can participate in this class.

The GREEN list contains the pieces which students should play.

The BLUE list contains the extra pieces which students might like to play.

Remember, the more pieces students know, the more they can enjoy playing together. When there is a piece they cannot play, they will listen to the other students – this is a great way of starting to learn these later pieces.
