Registration: At the commencement of Spring School please make your way to the registration desk (open from 8:15am on 23 September) at the school with plenty of time to receive a Student timetable, nametag, and Map, find your room and settle your child.

Changes to the program: Any changes to the program will be published at the Registration Desk.

Getting to the school: Train is the easiest way to travel to Spring School. The **Wahroonga** train station is a 10-minute walk from the school. There is parking available for 25 cars in the lower carpark and some available in the teacher carpark. There is plenty of parking in the surrounding streets. Please respect school neighbours by not blocking their driveways when parking and observe parking signs.

- All Students are responsible for their own lunch/snacks and drinks.
